Which will then be taken to market at VisitScotland Connect in April 2024.

Cruise Forth update from Peter Wilson

While the 2023 cruise season concluded in mid October, the 'quiet season 'is filled with business events, conferences, and preparation for another record breaking season in 2024. The first call at Rosyth is scheduled for 24th April, with 25 visits currently planned, however in 2023 we saw a number of additional ships diverted from other ports. Whether it be a transit call or passenger turnaround, there will be opportunities for hotels, taxis, coffee shops, gift shops and of course our attraction gems - the Abbey, Birthplace Museum, DCLG, Pittencrieff Park, and Abbot House.

CruiseForth is working to promote Dunfermline to cruise lines with calls on the other side of the Forth for shore excursions to the city.

Finally, the annual CruiseForth Summit will be held <u>on 23rd January</u>, with the Event for Businesses on 24th January.
