## **FIFE PILGRIM WAY**

The 64-mile Fife Pilgrim Way starts at Culross and North Queensferry, and meets in **Dunfermline** before winding through the less well-known greas of the Fife Heartlands. It passes medieval landmarks, industrial landscapes, and picturesque villages en route to St Andrews. The route has manageable sections which offer a few hours' walking or a long-distance challenge.


