## FIFE PILGRIM WAY

The 64-mile Fife Pilgrim Way starts at **Culross** or **North Queensferry**, meeting in **Dunfermline** before winding through the lesser-known Fife areas, passing medieval landmarks, industrial landscapes, and picturesque villages en route to **St Andrews**. The route features easy sections for short walks or longer challenges. Walkers in **Levenmouth** can connect with the route in **Windygates**.

## LEVENMOUTH RAIL LINK

Discover Levenmouth by rail with a direct link to the **Heartlands of Fife**, **Dunfermline** and **West Fife** and onto **Edinburgh** in around 1hr 15 minutes. The rail link allows you to visit the area **sustainably** with onward travel by bus, cycling or walking to the **East Neuk** of Fife. A short walk from Leven station is **Fife Heritage Railway**. Visit to take a ride on one of their vintage trains.

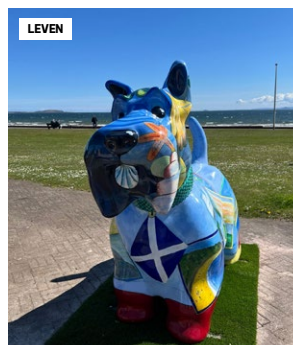
## ART & CULTURE

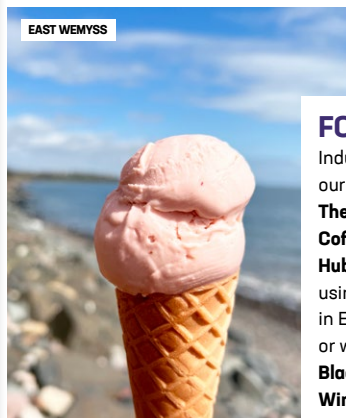

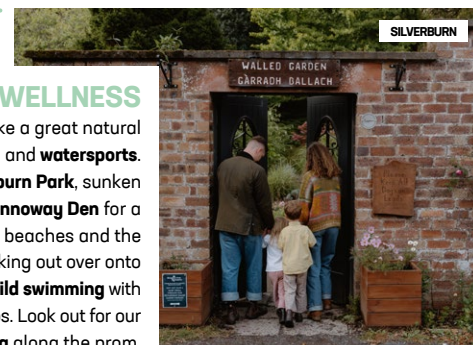
## HISTORY & HERITAGE

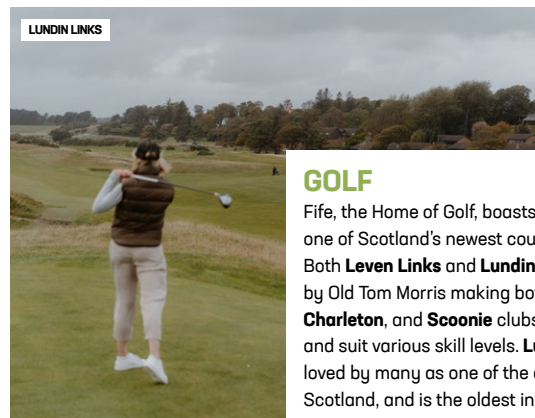
## OUTDOOR & WELLNESS
