

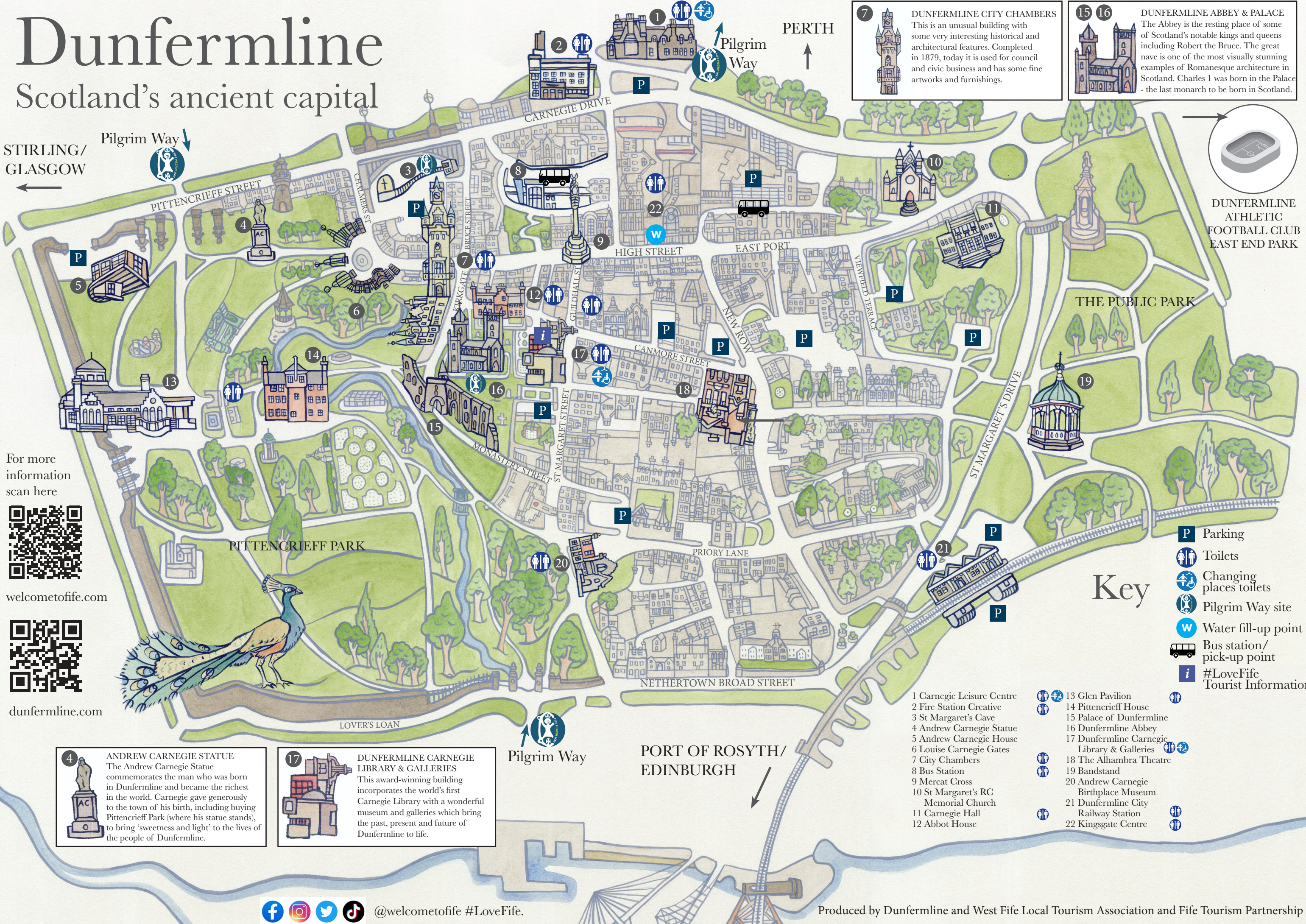

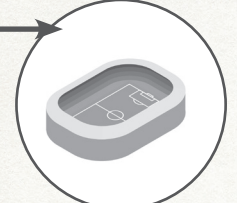

7 DUNFERMLINE CITY CHAMBERS
This is an unusual building with some very interesting historical and architectural features. Completed in 1879, today it is used for council and civic business and has some fine artworks and furnishings.

15 16 DUNFERMLINE ABBEY & PALACE
The Abbey is the resting place of some of Scotland's notable kings and queens including Robert the Bruce. The great nave is one of the most visually stunning examples of Romanesque architecture in Scotland. Charles 1 was born in the Palace - the last monarch to be born in Scotland.

4 ANDREW CARNEGIE STATUE
The Andrew Carnegie Statue commemorates the man who was born in Dunfermline and became the richest in the world. Carnegie gave generously to the town of his birth, including buying Pittencrieff Park (where his statue stands), to bring 'sweetness and light' to the lives of the people of Dunfermline.

17 DUNFERMLINE CARNEGIE LIBRARY & GALLERIES
This award-winning building incorporates the world's first Carnegie Library with a wonderful museum and galleries which bring the past, present and future of Dunfermline to life.
