

#### **DUNFERMLINE CARNEGIE** LIBRARY & GALLERIES

& Recreation, Transport, Conflict, Homes, and Royal Dunfermline. Discover your roots with the Local Studies Service and delight in the vibrant children's library. Learn about the Meldrum Loom and its role in Dunfermline's linen industry.



#### KIRKCALDY GALLERIES

Kirkcaldy Galleries is a one-stop cultural destination, housing a museum, art galleries, library, and more under one roof. The museum's "Moments in Time" exhibition showcases Kirkcaldy's history from ancient eras to the present day. Explore remarkable art collections, including works by Scottish Colourists Samuel J Peploe and William McTaggart. The building was originally built in 1925 as part of Kirkcaldy's War Memorial thanks to a generous donation by John Nairn, a local linoleum manufacturer. Notable artefacts include a rare 1847 floorcloth banner and a Cannel Coal Chair from Wemyss Castle.



#### ST ANDREWS MUSEUM

onfife.com/venues/st-andrews-museum Situated within the scenic Kinburn Park, St Andrews Museum occupies a stunning Victorian Mansion. On the ground floor visitors can explore the A-Z exhibition; each letter of the alphabet features star objects and images from the museum's collection, from A for Andrew to Z for Puzzling. Highlights of the collection include the Kilduncan Stone, an early Christian Cross Slab discovered in Kingsbarns in 2001, and a Bronze Age jet necklace found at Law Park in St Andrews in 1907. Upstairs, guests can enjoy captivating temporary exhibitions. The museum also hosts a variety of events and activities.

Fife Contemporary produces a high-quality program of visual art and craft exhibitions, events, and activities across various venues in Fife. Their mission is to support artists, makers, and the public by facilitating engagement and enriching lives through artistic experiences. Fife Contemporary frequently collaborates with OnFife Museums and Galleries, complementing their program with contemporary exhibitions exploring current themes. #### **ANDREW CARNEGIE BIRTHPLACE MUSEUM**

Step into the humble cottage where the titan of industry, Andrew Carnegie, was born in 1835. Explore the modest 18th-century weaver's dwelling, a stark contrast to the grandeur of his later life in New York as the richest man alive. Delve into Carnegie's early years as a bobbin boy, his journey to America in 1848, and his remarkable rise to become one of history's greatest philanthropists. Don't miss the memorial hall erected by Louise Carnegie, Andrew's widow, housing nearly 5000 objects that illuminate the couple's enduring legacy.



#### **WARDLAW MUSEUM**

The University of St Andrews, Scotland's first university established in 1413, boasts museums deeply rooted in its 600-year history of research and teaching. These museums hold approximately 115,000 artifacts and specimens, displayed across the campus and lent for exhibitions worldwide. The Wardlaw Museum features four thematic galleries highlighting the university's groundbreaking research and global impact, showcasing remarkable art, history, science, and natural history collections. Complemented by temporary exhibitions and interactive experiences, the museum offers a captivating cultural space for St Andrews, complete with a beautiful sea view from the terrace and garden.



#### ST ANDREWS HERITAGE **MUSEUM & GARDEN**

Explore the history of St Andrews, nestled in one of the oldest domestic dwellings in the town, a quaint 17th-century house and garden. Situated near the Cathedral and Castle, the museum and gardens offer a glimpse into its people and their stories, with displays depicting social, working, and domestic life. Wander through our hidden gem of gardens featuring a sensory garden and diverse plant varieties, alongside engaging exhibitions and installations. Don't miss the chance for a unique photo opportunity with a friend in our exclusive double-seater outdoor privy, a charming touch of St Andrews' heritage.



#### **R&A WORLD GOLF MUSEUM**

Our immersive galleries bring the past, present and future of golf to life. Explore over 400 years of golf's history on your tour of our outstanding sporting collection, rooted in St Andrews, recognised worldwide as the home of golf. Connect with the medieval origins of the game and discover its global development through golf's earliest societies, evolving equipment, groundbreaking fashion and championships. Discover engaging exhibitions and events, play in our Learning Room, and dress-up before holing a putt on our green. Visit the Shop and dine surrounded by views of The Royal and Ancient Clubhouse and historic Links in our rooftop restaurant.



#### **CUPAR MUSEUM & HERITAGE CENTRE**

Established to meet longstanding demands for a town museum, the Cupar Museum and Heritage Centre is housed in a former staff cottage at Cupar Railway Station, a significant structure dating back to 1847. This museum tells the story of Cupar's history as the County Town. Through semi-permanent displays and presentations on local topics, visitors can explore the town's past. The museum's collection is always growing and includes items like ephemera, paintings, and donated artifacts, many of which were saved for the community by our Trustees. It's a crucial repository of Cupar's heritage.



Fife Folk Museum provides a window on the social, economic and industrial heritage of Fife. The museum offers a Children's Trail, where young visitors can hunt for artefacts and enjoy Feely boxes and dressing up clothes. Regular workshops and drop-in sessions, including activities such as spoon carving, storytelling, painting, and themed workshops for children, are available. Don't miss the popular free monthly talks covering a variety of subjects. Additionally, the museum offers outreach visits to schools and adult groups, bringing history to life beyond its walls. Be sure to check out the 19th-century penny farthing bicycle on display!



#### **SAVE WEMYSS ANCIENT CAVES MUSEUM & VISITOR CENTRE**

Discover our Museum and Visitor Centre, conveniently located near the historic Wemyss caves, renowned for their ancient carvings, including early Pictish markings. Begin your cave exploration with a guided tour or embark on a virtual reality tour within the building, exploring displays that celebrate the area's rich natural and cultural heritage. The museum features unique items such as geological specimens, intriguing archaeological artefacts, cave-site discoveries, historic plaster casts, and local weaving and mining artefacts.



#### **CRAIL MUSEUM & HERITAGE CENTRE**

This museum and heritage centre offers visitors a small yet unique glimpse into local history. Showcasing unique stories from Crail Airfield, HMS Jackdaw WWII, and the fascinating JSSL, where Russian was taught to decoders and spies during the Cold War, it captivates with its rich heritage. The Burgh Room includes timelines tracing back to the Royal Charter granted by Robert the Bruce in 1311 and beyond. Explore the vibrant local Herring trade and the legacy of the Kingo family, skilled weavers who once called Crail home. Visitors can also enjoy guided walks on Sunday afternoons, led by knowledgeable locals, offering a comprehensive exploration of Crail's colourful past.

### **SCOTTISH FISHERIES MUSEUM**

Located on the harbour front of a lively fishing port, the Scottish Fisheries Museum is renowned nationally and internationally. Its extensive museum aims to engage visitors of all ages in the evolution of the Scottish commercial fishing industry and the lives of fisherfolk. Highlighting constant innovation, the museum features full-sized historic boats like the Zulu-class "Research," alongside artefacts, photographs, fine art and costumes. Delve into Scotland's maritime heritage - a highlight not to be missed is the opportunity to admire the sea-going flagship, the 1902 herring drifter "Reaper."



#### FORTH BRIDGES LIGHTHOUSE MUSEUM

Discover the Forth Bridges Lighthouse Museum, home to the world's smallest working Light Tower, offering stunning views of the historic Queensferry Passage. From Queen Margaret to Queen Victoria, this crossing has royal connections dating back centuries. Learn about its formal constitution in 1809, closure in 1964, and the evolution of the Forth Bridge in 1890, Forth Road Bridge in 1964, and the new Queensferry Crossing in 2017. Enjoy panoramic views of all three bridges spanning three centuries. Pick up a Forth Bridges Trail map for a historic walk or complete a circular trail for a personal certificate. Advance bookings allow you to light the historic lamp, echoing the past.

The Museum of Communication enlightens, educates, and entertains visitors by showcasing the evolution of communication technology. Through rescued artefacts spanning 200 years, the museum illustrates the stages of design, improvement, and change in communication devices. Young guests can explore the development of smartphones, while older visitors can reminisce about radios, TVs, and phones from their youth. The exhibits make the history of communication accessible to all, with everyday objects presented with clear explanations in simple language.



#### **SCOTTISH VINTAGE BUS MUSEUM**

At the Scottish Vintage Bus Museum, you'll find a collection of approximately 180 buses and artifacts showcasing Scotland's bus industry from the 1930s. Visitors enjoy guided tours of the expansive site aboard a vintage bus, with stops at the restoration workshop. Feel free to explore the large Exhibition Hall, complete with a café and shop.


